An installation of InDesign Server must be existing.

This tutorial will describe how to get a trial license for it

QUICK EXPLANATION



To get a trial license for InDesign Server, you'll need the Adobe Application Manager Enterprise Edition (AAMEE) to be able to run a command line which will generate it!

Steps will be:

- Download corresponding AAMEE
- Run the correct command line



DOWNLOAD AAMEE



- Go on the adobe website to get the AAMEE :

Adobe Application Manager Enterprise Edition (AAMEE) provides a straightforward and customizable way to wrap CS 5 and 5.5 applications and their updates as MSI or PKG packages for silent deployment across the enterprise.



START AAMEE




- Execute the file « ApplicationManagerEnterprise_X.X.exe »
- Extract the files into a folder (on your desktop for example):





- After a few minutes of preparation the AAMEE installer will be displayed: **DO NOT DO ANYTHING BUT JUST QUIT OR CLOSE IT!**





COMMAND LINE



Just by preparing the AAMEE installer, Adobe installed the required components to generate the trial license.

- Open a command line as « Administrator » and run the following command to go to the utility folder we need:

```
cd C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Adobe\OOBE\PDApp\Enterprise\utilities\APTEE\CS6
```

- Or, for InDesign Server 5 or 5.5:

```
cd C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Adobe\OOBE\PDApp\Enterprise\utilities\APTEE\CS5_5
```

Then, you need the «Adobe leid » depending on your InDesign Server version.

- Run this command line for InDesign Server CC 2015:

adobe_prtk --tool=StartTrial --leid=V7{}InDesignServer-11-Win-GM

- Run this command line for InDesign Server CS6:

adobe_prtk --tool=StartTrial --leid=InDesignServer-CS6-Win-GM

- Run this command line for InDesign Server 5.5:

adobe_prtk --tool=StartTrial --leid=InDesignServer-CS5.5-Win-GM

- Run this command line for InDesign Server 5:

adobe_prtk --tool=StartTrial --leid=InDesignServer-CS5-Win-GM

After the execution of the command line, your InDesign Server should have the trial license!
